Hello! I hope that your semester has been off to a good start! Here is the **February President's Report**.

Our next Faculty Assembly meeting will be on **Friday, February 9th in Dwire 114 or via Teams**. Janice Thorpe and Martin Key will be joining us to share and discuss information about **microcredentials**. The **FA Grievance Committee** will be sharing their **updated bylaws**. **Please see corresponding documents** that were attached in the **email sent by Lynn Gates**, the FA Secretary, on Friday, 2/2. **UBAC** and key leadership participated in an all-day retreat on January 30th. Highlights from the retreat will be shared at our 2/9 meeting by VCAF Kathy Kaoudis and FACB Chair David Moon.

Some **enrollment highlights** from the beginning of the semester. (Please note that these are numbers provided from the first week of classes in mid-January and have likely changed. However, they can still provide us with a good picture.)

- Student headcounts are +0.30% ahead of this week last year (without adjustment for time).
- On Jan. 19, new student enrollment was +.30% ahead of this week last year.
 - We are ahead with new freshmen by 9.1%
 - We are ahead in new Transfer students by 3.1%.
- Student credit hours continue to be positive range (+0.1%).
- New International enrollment is +9.5%.
- Non-resident enrollment has surpassed last year. We have a 6.77% lead in head count, and a 6.3% lead in credit hours.
- Non-resident new student credit hours are ahead of last spring end of term by 48.9%.d

3. APS 5060 - IRC faculty titles – continuing discussion on the implementation and adoption.
