

Faculty Representative Assembly Notice of Motion

Commitment to Campus Community

**Whereas** the University of Colorado Colorado Springs faculty recognize that campus communities connected with both Palestine and Israel are facing immeasurable struggles in the wake of historical and ongoing violence;

Whereas the faculty affirm a culture of care, compassion, and responsiveness to suffering;

Whereas the faculty lead with a culture of care and compassion for students, staff, and faculty;

Whereas the faculty affirm the university's dedication to free expression and scholarly inquiry that creates opportunities for people to learn, discuss, and process ongoing events;

**Be it resolved** that the faculty of the Faculty Representative Assembly at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs:

- 1. remain committed to supporting community members from all backgrounds;
- 2. remain committed to the mission of the University of Colorado as a "transformative public university," which "promotes the interchange of ideas in the pursuit of truth and learning, including diversity of race, culture, geography, political, intellectual and philosophical perspectives";
- 3. remain committed to recognizing that both Palestinian and Israeli families, friends, and neighbors are impacted by the continuing violence; and
- 4. remain committed to community members (students, faculty, and staff) who are impacted by the events in Palestine and Israel.
