

## Updating APS 1025 for P/F

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## **APS 1025 – Uniform Grading**

- Changes to APS 1025 require a vote of all the faculty in all the colleges on all the campuses
- Before we begin the voting process, we want to frame the issue to the campuses and get faculty feedback
- Based on feedback we will craft a proposed change to the APS, get EPUS feedback and EPUS would administer the voting process
- Proposal has been reviewed by the Registrars and has their support
  - This is, at least on the surface, a very simple change



#### **APS 1025 Before Covid**

- "P/F P grade is not included in the grade point average; the F grade is included; any grade above F is regarded as passing H/P/F honors/pass/fail - intended for honors courses; credit hours count toward the degree but are not included in the grade-point average"
- Reality two versions of P/F
  - Courses that were P/F only i.e., non-letter grade courses where the only grade entered by faculty is P/F – very limited number of courses
  - Student option/elected P/F faculty enters letter grade and system converts D- and above to P



#### **Temporary because of Covid**

- Campuses given permission to alter timing of P/F for Fall 20, Spring 21 to support students
- CDHE requested institutions provide a mechanism to indicate when P was a passing grade, i.e., C- or better. This was in support of transfer and the variations in P across Colorado IHEs
  - CU President made a temporary allowance for campuses to introduce P+ meaning C- or better. This led to P+/P/F.



## Challenges

- P/F only courses have no use for P+/P/F it makes no sense
- Capturing the 'D' grades in student option P/F is important for financial aid purposes
- There seems to be support on the campuses for maintaining P+/P/F for the student option P/F for a variety of reasons including prerequisites and continued compliance with CDHE



## Suggested Path Forward

- For courses with no letter grade option, e.g., experiential, field-based, practical or seminar-type courses, and candidacy for degree placeholder enrollments introduce <u>Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory</u>
  - S/U For S grades, credits are earned, but not quality points; no credits or quality points are earned for U grades.
- For student elected option P+/P/F
  - P+=C- or above
  - P = D+, D or D-
  - F, no change
