

EPUS Committee Report May 2020

EPUS met on April 13 and April 27 and discussed the comments and questions from the Faculty Assembly discussion of the draft of the proposed Grade Forgiveness Policy. The latest draft of the policy was shared with Brett Fugate, Director of Academic Advising, Tracy Barber, Registrar, and Chris DuVal, Director of Degree Audit and Transfer Credit and the Retention and Graduation Subcommittee of the Enrollment Strategy Committee and their comments, questions and suggestions were also discussed. A 'final' revised draft was sent to Aaron Burton, Campus Policy and Space Usage Professional who will route it through the Campus Policy Process (UCCS Policy 100-001). The policy will come back to EPUS and Faculty Assembly in the fall for a last review.

The committee chair, Andrea Hutchins, submitted comments and suggestions addressing revisions to CU APS 5060 Faculty Workloads.

The next EPUS committee meetings will be held during the fall semester. The schedule will be determined in August based on schedules of the committee members. Norah Mazel will be serving as interim chair for the committee for the fall semester while Andrea Hutchins is on sabbatical.
