

EPUS Committee Report
November 2017

- EPUS met on October 27, 2017.
- The committee reviewed the edits to UCCS Policy 200-019 Student Academic Ethics Code Violations and endorsed the revised policy.
- The committee reviewed the draft of the campus's Film and Photography policy and guidelines and provided feedback to the policy and guidelines author.
- The committee reviewed the memo from Michael Lightner regarding the changes being considered for Regent Article and Policy 5. Regent Article and Policy 5 are the 'faculty' article and policy, focusing on many issues that are important to faculty including academic freedom, tenure and faculty grievance procedures, the definition of faculty, and appointment and evaluation processes. A response from EPUS has been drafted and is being reviewed by the committee. The response will be sent to the Regent Laws and Policy Review Steering Committee next week.
 - As has been stated in several Faculty Assembly Committee and officer reports, the proposed changes to this policy require faculty attention and comment. All faculty may individually provide comment regarding the proposed changes and are highly encouraged to do so.
