Our final Faculty Representative Assembly meeting for this academic year is on Friday, May 10, 2019 in UC303. The agenda has been sent out by email. Please review it, and if you have questions or concerns that you want brought forward, contact your College representatives and let them know.

Here is an update on what is happening at the campus and system levels.

CU Presidential Finalist – As we all know, the Board of Regents has named Mr. Mark Kennedy as in-coming CU President after a lengthy search process. Admittedly, there was controversy regarding Mr. Kennedy's appointment and many UCCS faculty did not believe he was the best choice to replace President Benson. However, now that the Board of Regents has officially made its decision, we anticipate building a collaborative relationship with Mr. Kennedy. Our goal is and always will be to ensure that UCCS and the CU system continue to prosper. During Mr. Kennedy's campus presentation here at UCCS, he acknowledged that his primary role as CU President would be to ensure the financial health of the university by building relationships with donors.
