Our first **Faculty Assembly meeting is on Friday, September 8, from 12pm to 2 pm in UC 304**. This is a full faculty meeting so all faculty members – not just representatives – are encouraged and welcome to attend. We will be discussing several important topics that I have highlighted below:

- Faculty Course Questionnaire. As many of you may be aware, FCQs will be administered online starting in the fall 2017 semester. Additionally, a system-wide committee has been working to revise FCQs across the CU campuses. After researching various instruments, collecting faculty feedback and conducting two pilot studies, the committee has recommended adopting a new set of questions. Some things to note, each question will have a "not applicable" option as not all questions will be applicable to all courses. Also, each department will have the ability to add up to five of their own questions to the questionnaire. Please take a look at the new questions (which are attached) and provide feedback to your College's Faculty Assembly Representatives before next Friday. The Faculty Representative Assembly will be voting on whether to go forward with these new questions at the September 8th meeting.
