

**UCCS Faculty Representative Assembly  
President's Report  
February 8, 2013**

- The results of the faculty poll for the course forgiveness policy indicated that a majority of those casting a vote were in favor of considering a policy on course forgiveness. 177 faculty voted; 113 (64%) were in favor of considering a policy and 64 (36%) were not in favor of considering a policy. EPUS will be drafting a policy this semester for consideration by the faculty.
- The faculty voted 84% (166 votes) to 16% (32 votes) in favor of supporting the proposed general education curriculum model with a majority of the faculty from each college voting in favor of the model. The Taskforce for Phase III of the General Education Revision: Implementation is being assembled.


