 - Liaison with the ADA Taskforce (have a member of DisC on that committee, currently Heather Albanesi)
 - To review policies and practices relevant to faculty with disabilities and make recommendations of any needed policy changes in order to create an academic environment that fosters the academic success of faculty with disabilities
 - Pursue a "beyond compliance" approach
 - Working to assure fairness in the recruitment and retention of faculty with disabilities
 - Working with other standing committees (e.g. FMAC or the Faculty women's committee) to developing and enhance support networks for faculty with disabilities
 - o Seek out opportunities for events/speakers to include disability focus
