- IAAC met on October 26, 2017.
- Director Gibson gave an update on the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) meetings, which were held in Golden. The following issues were discussed:
 - A mental health initiative
 - Concussion Management

Director Gibson outlined the program that UCCS follows for mental health screening in conjunction with the Health and Wellness Center on campus as well as the concussion management baseline testing done with UCCS student athletes.

Director Gibson updated the committee that Dixie State in St. George Utah will join the RMAC in 2018
