- I. NTTF discussed updates from previous Faculty Assembly and their impacts on NTT faculty
  - a. Chancellor updates
    - i. Spring enrollment down 25%
    - ii. Cabinet still discussing spring semester and to spring break or not to spring break
    - iii. EDI position
    - iv. Furloughs
    - v. Online degree initiatives
  - b. Provost update
    - i. Still hopeful about starting the 3<sup>rd</sup> tier promotions with this year's evaluation cycle
    - ii. Drop deadline moved to last day of semester
  - c. Budget update with Suzanne Scott
    - i. FY 22 is in the process of planning, able to raise tuition up to 3%
    - ii. 0% raises
  - d. Other business
    - i. Students on the waitlist will be enrolled in Canvas
    - ii. System moving to Zoom starting in January
- II. New committee title
  - a. Committee is ready to go with name change – need Faculty Assembly approval
  - b. Committee understands there are a lot of issues right now and is not pushing this as an absolute priority – just that we are ok when this happens
