- Formation of New Task Forces at Systemic Level
 - Norah: University system is forming Task Forces (“committees”)
 - One will examine and assess the degree that the policy statement requiring “multiple means of evaluation” is being implemented on all campuses
 - Another will assess FCQs
 - NTTF committee will work to ensure NTTF serve on both task forces
- Status of Current NTTF Committee Members and Election of Chair for AY 2016-17
 - Christine Robinson was elected Chair for AY 2016-17
- Ongoing Uncompensated Merit Issues
 - revisited questions raised about the viability and effects of model used to address uncompensated merit issues
- Committee Record System and Archive
 - Norah: proposed devising a method for tracking recurring projects
 - Sheri: suggested also creating an archive of important committee documents
 - discussion merits further investigation and consideration of various possible modalities
- Annual Differentiated Workload Plan for NTTF
 - further discussion re differences between departments in how adjust teaching load to account for service load
- Informal Assessment of Guidelines for Promotion to Senior Instructor and Merit Evaluations
 - Christine: in process of collecting documents provided to NTTF in various colleges and departments for comparative analysis
