- FA Announcements per November Meeting
 - Regent's Laws Article/Policy 5 (A/P5): still possible to comment on revisions
 - steering committee only received 10 comments total from all 3 campuses; certainly not representative of our faculty

 - Faculty-List: Maja Krakowiak (FA President) says 30% of UCCS faculty has all Faculty-list emails automatically going to Junk Email
 - Maja asks FA Reps to encourage faculty members to accept emails from Faculty-L so opportunities to speak on own behalf are not missed
 - FCQ Task Force: survey is being conducted; task force will be looking for feedback on new FCQ questions; link will be sent via Faculty-L
 - Regent's CU Online Proposal: faculty can email Maja with any comments/concerns
 - Mike: will ask Janice to email her articulate and well-informed comments directly to Maja
- Address Compression Issues and Salary Adjustments
 - committee agrees to monitor Personnel and Benefits (P&B) Committee meeting minutes and to continue to seek better data beyond CUPA data which does not account for senior instructor pay level
- Formalize NTTF Rights and Responsibilities Document
 - update at next meeting in 2018
- Investigate and Seek Promotion Beyond Sr. Instructor New Faculty Appointments
 - Christine: submitted memorandum to steering committee on behalf of NTTF committee that includes mention of second promotional level; also emailed copy of memo to faculty encouraging faculty to comment
 - committee agrees to monitor Regent's Laws steering committee's draft of A/P5 due early December and respond as needed
- Collect and Interpret Data on Lecturers' Roles and Salaries on Campus
 - committee agrees to prioritize this work in 2018; will seek data (or way to collect data) from appropriate offices
 - Janice via email: agrees to analyze data collected beginning Spring 2018
