1. House Bill 1144 (multi-year contracts for NTTF):

HB 1144 sponsored by Rep. Randy Fischer passed all committee hearings and the House and the Senate votes. It is scheduled for signing by the Governor, Thursday April 12, 2012. Members from the education community state wide testified at the hearings and others contacted their local legislators to voice their support for the bill. Implementation of multi-year contracts within CU still requires approval by the Board of Regents. The NTTF committee and other supporters of the Bill will follow up on further action.

The document will be voted on at the April 13 FRA meeting. After approval, the NTTF committee will work to educate and guide the Colleges and NTTF on the policy and assist with any implementation issues.
