UCCS Faculty colleagues:

UCCS Faculty Assembly and the Provost's office are sponsoring a series of Faculty Forums this year. The first forums will focus on updating Reappointment, Promotion and Tenure (RPT) criteria. Future forums will look at topics such as merit review processes, instructor issues (new promotional level and multi-year contracts) and other issues.

As you may be aware, the CU system has done extensive revisions of Regent Law and Policy. They are currently revising Administrative Policy Statements. All of this leads to ALL primary units needing to revise their RPT criteria this academic year. Over the past 6 months, I have been meeting with various groups to collect ideas on RPT revisions that we might consider. The attached document summarizes some key changes in CU system policies and some ideas that we can consider in revising our RPT criteria.

To begin this discussion, we have scheduled three faculty forums where I will summarize some of the issues contained in the attached document and we will have an opportunity to discuss these issues and to introduce other issues that you feel we should explore as we consider our RPT criteria.
