SENATE ASSEMBLED THAT:**

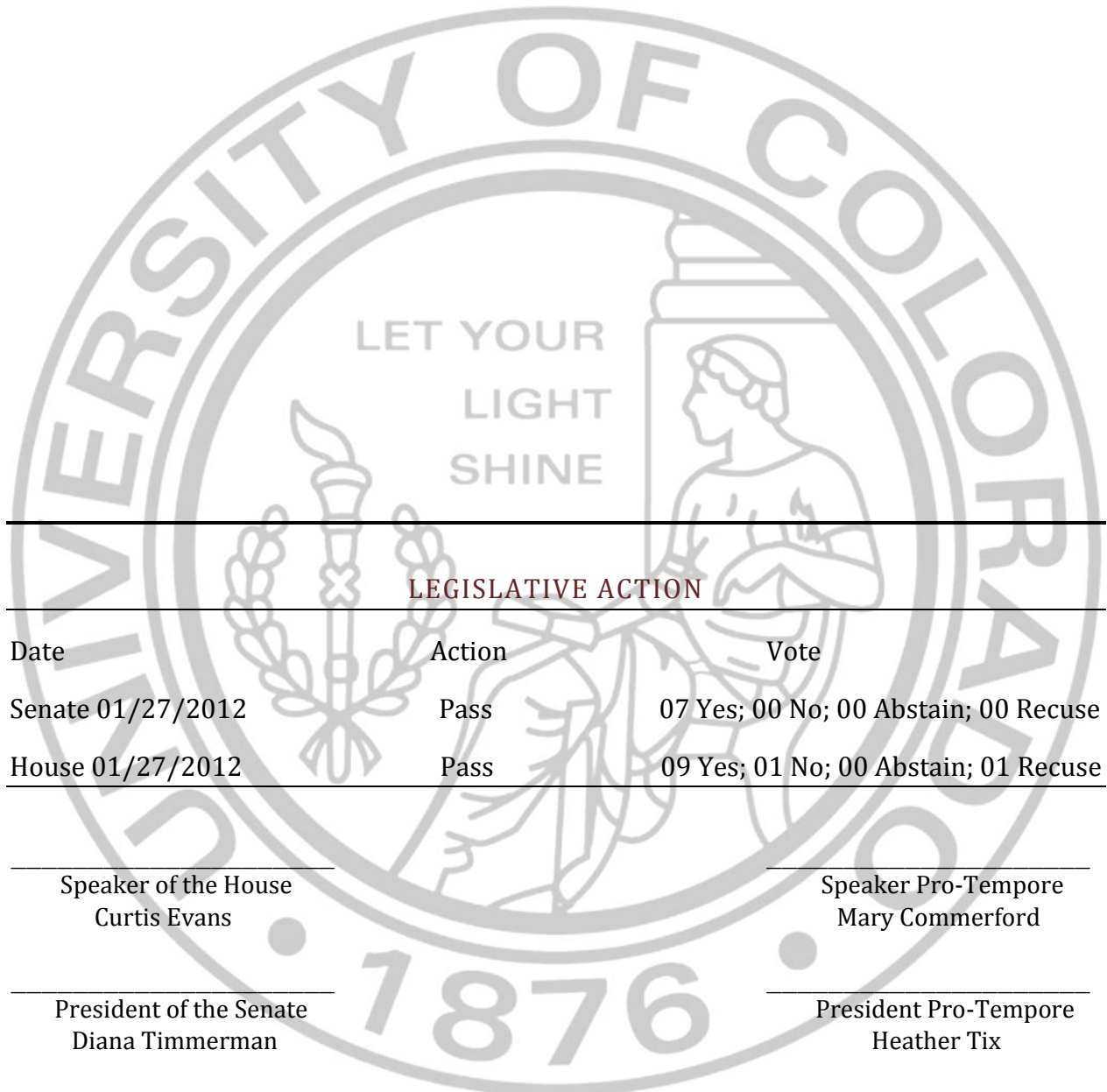
Section 1: Grade forgiveness is defined as the replacement of a grade (instead of an averaging) once an individual retakes a class.

Section 2: The original grade the student received is forgiven and replaced by the new grade.

Section 3: Students have the opportunity to receive higher GPA's with grade forgiveness.
