- Those in attendance at campus presentation identified major issues with both proposed locations, cultural and environmental in the case of site 1, and environmental/geological in the case of site 2
- Speculation that a third site, the parking area behind the current engineering building, would avoid the cultural/environmental issues with sites 1 and 2

Other Topics

- Kimberly Reeves has been the Interim Director of the Office of Sustainability since before the pandemic began
 - This position needs to be permanently filled if the campus is to restore its sustainability efforts to pre-COVID19 levels, and it will be a challenge to complete and implement a new campus Sustainability Strategic Plan without a permanent director at the Office.
 - Action: Joel will take this to Faculty Assembly, contacting David Moon prior to the next
 Faculty Assembly meeting with our concerns.
- UCCS Fight for \$15 (actionnetwork.org)
 - A petition is circulating to set a \$15 minimum payrate for UCCS student employees.
 - Living wage research for Colorado Springs/El Paso County suggests that workers need to make at least \$16.77/hr to earn a living wage and that's just for single adults with no dependents.
 - CU Boulder, CU Denver and CU Anschutz have all recently raised their minimum wage to \$15.
