NEW BUSINESS

1. Content ownership: whether a faculty member or the University owns an online course if a stipend was paid to develop it depends on the nature of the contract or agreement
2. Update on University of Colorado Connect
 - a. Course development funds ready for distribution
 - i. Proportional to size of campus
 - ii. \$740K over three years; hold-back for performance; could be near \$1M
 - b. Insist we not break contracts with LMSs, but work toward a single LMS as they expire
 - c. Working on marketing campaign
 - d. Enrollments up 22% in HS concurrent
 - e. connect.cu.edu still dysfunctional
3. COMM concerns
 - a. Verifying minimum technology (hardware/software) requirements
 - b. 24/7 support for students (esp. non-Blackboard items)
4. Invite members from colleges/departments to hear about concerns, hopes?
 - a. Dave contact Deans
 - b. Use the GE model: go to department/college meetings
5. How to grow programs with no new faculty lines while at the same time minimizing overloads?
 - a. Limiting overloads is a huge (and nonsensical!) issue
