Hi everyone,

Here's your final UBAC update for the year.

Legislative update: the Legislature finished its session without approving merit-based aid for Colorado students and without making any changes to the existing law permitting concealed weapons on campus.

CU Foundation reorganization update: President Benson has decided that the current structure of the CU Foundation should be replaced. On the new structure, Foundation employees will be University of Colorado employees who are accountable to Chancellors and Deans. There will be an accelerated search for a new Foundation director conducted by a search committee comprised of chancellors, vice-presidents, and the President. The hope is to have someone in place by September 1, 2013.

Enrollment update: Summer and Fall enrollments are currently up about 5%. We hope to have 1550 new freshmen in the fall.

Budget update: SEVCAF Burnett distributed a Budget Projections Spreadsheet.

Construction update: everything currently under construction is on or nearly on schedule. The new office building on Austin Bluffs will be five floors high. The fifth floor will be at least shelled in, and if there's enough money (about \$2.5 million), it will be finished.

Bachelor's of Innovation in Inclusive Early Childhood Education: A motion to approve the proposal for this College of Education proposal was passed.
