UBAC Update

The February 28, 2014 meeting of UBAC began with a legislative update from VCAF Burnett, who reported that: (i) the concealed weapons on campus bill in the Colorado Legislature has passed the House and is now in the Senate, and (ii) the Chancellor will be appearing at the Legislature to provide the UCCS perspective on the bill permitting community colleges to offer a limited number of 4 year degrees. VCAF Burnett continued by reviewing the UCCS Budget Presentation to the Regents from the Regent meeting held at UCCS on 2/20 and 2/21. As did the other campuses, UCCS offered three models for tuition increases for 2013-2014: the mandatory model (.6% tuition increase), the market model (6% tuition increase), and the market plus model (8.1% tuition increase). VCAF Burnett continued with a budget update, which focused on a model for capital renewal funding. Faculty may be re-assured that even in the absence of state capital moneys for facilities maintenance, the campus is committed! to maintaining our campus. Finally, UBAC Chair Spicher led a discussion on the UBAC Scholarship.
