The number of college representatives will be revised, if needed, to account for the growth of the faculty body, maintaining equitable proportional representation among the colleges. Also, in order to ensure an equitable representations of the various areas (Humanities, Social Sciences, and Physical and Natural Sciences) in the College of LAS, some revisions of the ballots and voting procedures are being explored and discussed. All these issues will be brought up to Faculty Assembly in the Fall, for possible implementation in the next FA elections next Spring.
