

Campus – Educational Policy and University Standards (EPUS) Committee Report

- The campus EPUS committee has reviewed and forwarded the Animals on Campus POLICY NUMBER: 400-012 this week's Faculty Assembly meeting for approval. The policy outlines restriction for pets and exceptions for Service Animals and Emotional Support Animals.
- EPUS will be working on an Information IT policy on Responsible Computing POLICY NUMBER: 700-002. This is a revision to a previous policy and we are waiting for a red-lined version before we proceed.
- We will be taking a look again at course forgiveness based on a student governance request for changes to existing campus practice.
- I have done some preliminary work with campus administration a revision to the Intellectual Property Policy. Once changes have been proposed, the policy will move to the EPUS committee.
- Additionally, I have not forgotten about our quest to make possible calendar changes that we dealt with at the end of last year. I have had some conversations with the campus administration about what types of calendar changes would be desirable and acceptable. EPUS will be considering changes in the next few months. You will be hearing from me on this later.
