

Campus – Educational Policy and University Standards (EPUS) Committee Report

February 12, 2016 - *Mark R. Malone, Chair*

- At the request of the Faculty Assembly Executive committee I have looked into issues raised by student governance regarding course forgiveness at this campus. After having discussed this with the chair the CU System EPUS Committee, gathered information from the registrar of the Boulder Campus, and having conducted my own review of the literature, I have concluded that student assertions about UCCS being out of line with other campuses on “course forgiveness” are unsupportable. Unless students or faculty have future additional requests, we will take no action.
- I have continued to work with the ad hoc committee on the Intellectual Property Policy. This work is being revised based on additional input. Once changes have been completed, the policy will move to the EPUS committee.
- Additionally, the committee will meet this spring to consider potential changes to the academic calendar begun last year.

System EPUS Activities
